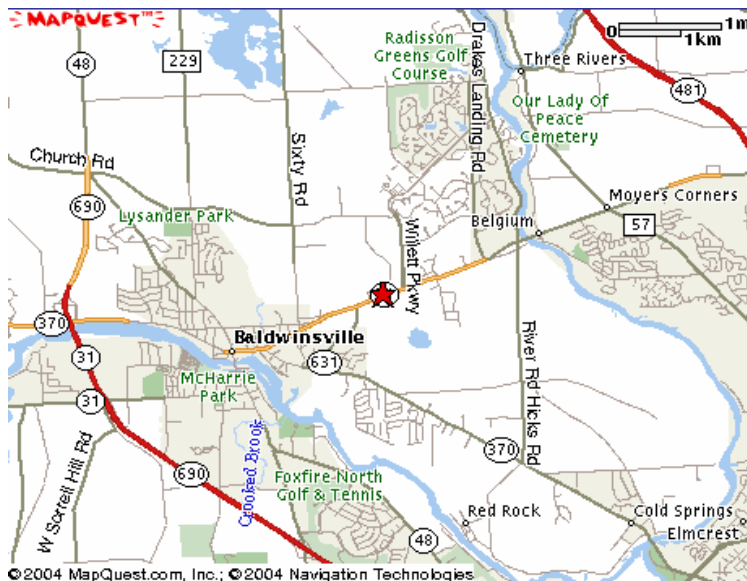

DIRECTIONS:

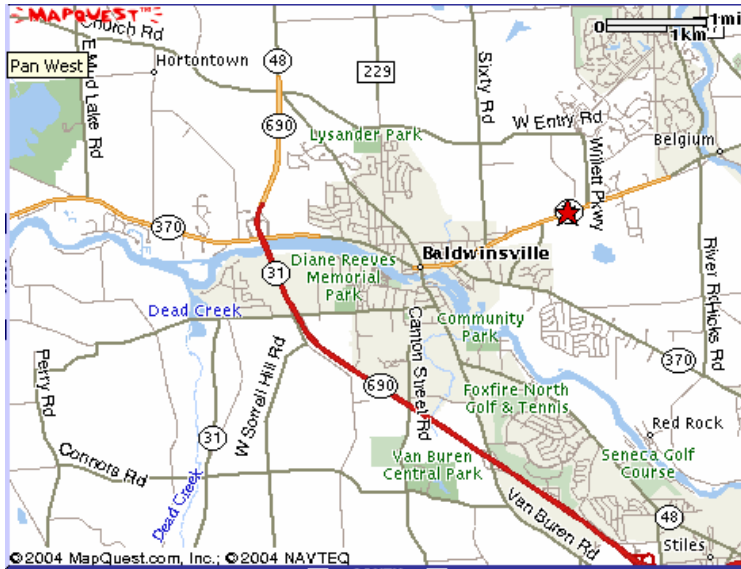
FROM THE NORTH, SOUTH, OR EAST

I 481 north to Route 31, follow Rt. 31 west, cross route 57, cross Seneca River, watch for Sunshine Mini Mart on left, approximately 500 yards after Mini Mart make right turn into brewery entrance. Take right at fork towards East side of the brewery and drive up to gate 2.



FROM THE WEST

I 90 east to Route 690, Route 690 north to Route 370, Route 370 is combined with Route 31 at this point. Route 370/31 east thru village of Baldwinsville; Stay on Route 31 east when Route 370 turns to south. The brewery is on the left. Turn into brewery entrance. Take right at fork towards East side of the brewery and drive up to gate 2.



OTHER DESTINATIONS:

- The closest decent hotel is Fairfield Inn at 3979 Route 31, Clay, NY 13041, 315-622-2576. It is new and easy drive from the brewery or the airport. Several acceptable restaurants close by.
- From airport to Fairfield Inn take I81 north, exit to I481 north, exit to Route 31 West (i.e. left at end of ramp), hotel about 1/8 mile on your right.
- From Fairfield Inn to brewery; make right turn from hotel entrance road on Route 31, straight west two miles to cross Seneca River, one mile to Sunshine Mini Mart on the left, 500 yards after Mini Mart make right turn into Brewery entrance.
- From brewery to Fairfield Inn: Leave brewery, turn left onto Rt. 31 east. Cross the river, then 2 miles to left turn - before crossing I481 overpass, easy.
- From Airport to Marriott Courtyard hotel. This is not the shortest but it is easier. Leave airport, stay in right lane, exit right onto I-81 North ramp then switch to left lane and merge left onto I-81 North. On I-81 about 1-2 miles to exit # 29, stay in right lane, exit to I-481 south. About 5-6 miles to exit right on Route 298. Turn right at end of ramp. Follow Rt. 298 west about 2.5 miles. After a long curve to the right watch for the hotel on the right. CONTINGENCY: If you miss the hotel you will come to "Carrier Circle" which is a circular cloverleaf and you can drive 360 degrees (counterclockwise) around the cloverleaf and exit onto Rt. 298 east get back to the hotel.
- From the Marriott Courtyard to the brewery: Make left turn out of the hotel onto Rt. 298 east. About 2.5 miles ahead you will drive under the I-481 underpass then get in left lane and make left turn onto I-481 north. About 12 miles, stay in right lane and exit at Route 31 (Baldwinsville, Cicero, Great Northern Mall). Move to left lane of ramp. Left turn on Route 31. Move to right lane. Stay on Rt 31 about 2 miles and cross the Seneca River. Then 1 mile to Sunshine Mini Mart on left. 500 yards after Mini Mart make right turn into Brewery entrance.
- From brewery to airport: Leave brewery, turn left onto Rt. 31 east. Cross the river, stay in right lane, then 2 miles to exit right onto I-481 south. About 7 miles, exit right onto I-81 south. About 2.5 miles stay right, exit 27 to airport.

PRE-VISIT COMMUNICATION:

SHOES: Hard leather uppers, enclosed toes, no flip flops, no high heels in production areas

SHIRTS: Cannot be sleeveless

PANTS: Cannot be shorts

CAMERAS: Photography **MUST** be pre-approved or leave cameras in car.

SECURITY: Security will check you in and direct you to your destination. Please follow all posted traffic signs.

When touring the brewery please use common sense and be aware at all times, as this is a production facility. Think safety first!
